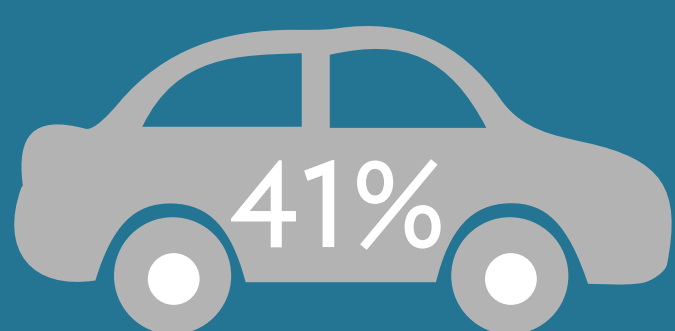

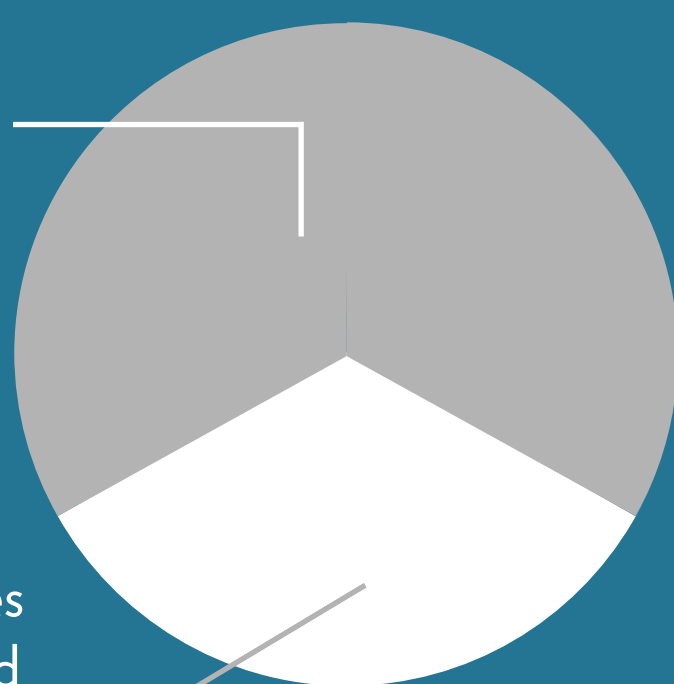
Motor vehicle accidents cost employers \$60 BILLION ANNUALLY

of the average vehicle miles traveled per household are from commuting to and from work (27%) and driving on work-related business (14%)

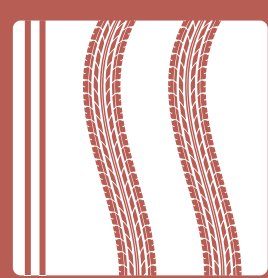
\$40 Billion from on-the-job crashes

ALARMING STATISTICS

89% of fatally injured workers were male
