

PROTECT YOUR PROPERTY



Secure windows and doors

- deadbolts help to keep doors from flying open
- board up windows

Protect the roof

- seal roof deck
 - use roofing cement to fix loose tiles/shingles
 - evaluate gutters

Trim Trees

get rid of dead sections on trees

Seal gaps

 apply caulk to gaps where water can enter: gas pipes, air conditioning pipes, electrical outlets, etc.

Redirect pooling water

- flood waters over 3 ft create pressure on walls, causing cracks and increasing the potential of a collapse.
- evaluate drainage of property and add ground or drains to help move the water away from the building.
